Equal Pay day is September 4. This date illustrates the 66 extra days women have to work after the end of the financial year to earn the same as men.

- Female graduates on entering the workforce earn \$3,000 pa less than male graduates²
- Women executive managers in Australia's Top 200 companies earn an average of 28.3% less than their male peers³
