1.2 Preparation and planning	I would like more people working for forrestry parks and electricity companies to have people on the ground and to do more controlled work.  Controlled back burning and opening up roads. Tree planting and clearing of fire breaks by doing this is will reduce the fuel loads. Preparation with that work reduces the need to rely on the aircraft and would save money and then more people can be employed locally on the ground and less reliance on the aircraft.
1.3 Response to bushfires	More local knowledge and better communications. When the power goes out there is no phone service, no way to be contacted or make contact.
