I am also concerned that this situation of hotter, long summers and generally more extreme weather is the new normal because of climate change. I am a social worker in coffs and i have also seen first hand the psycological strain as and increased anxiety these fires and concerns about climate change are having on our residents.

Then there are the increased admissions through the direct health impact of fires and smoke, climate change is a real health issue and will cost us more than we understand right now. We must do everything in our power to stop any further deforestation and we must cut carbon emission to net zero as fast as possible. This government is not working fast enough and i believe they really do not understand that there is no planet B and there is no ecomony or life without a healthy planet.
