We stayed at home on the edge of the National Park that was destroyed by the firestorm. We survived and houses intact through hard work by neighbors and myself but it takes a toll and even my mother said we were lucky to survive. My issues were the aftermath we had no way to communicate with the outside world and if you had a battery powered radio you could get updates but there was a lot of misinformation going around. In this day and age the fact that we did not have communication to the outside world was ridiculous especially when they thought the whole area was burnt
