# 1.1 Causes and contributing factors

Land use planning and management and building standards, including appropriate clearing and other hazard reduction, zoning, and any appropriate use of indigenous practices.

I would urge strict caution in allowing residents residing near bush areas to use the 10/50 Clearing Code to clear their property on a self-assessment basis. Many demolition sites around me in Epping are totally cleared of trees, despite specific instructions approved to leave the trees or replace them. Even more freedom to remove trees will have a devastating impact on the already fragile tree canopy system.

Real Estate values are much higher in areas where there is shade and leaf - why reduce the value of our homes?
