Your story	We have been very fortunate in Khancoban with the bush fires, even though we had evacuated for over a week due to the real danger to the town. We had little other impact apart from the smoke. We were lucky that Snowy Hydro has an independent communications network and made it available to locals to use for information and contact. Many other areas had no access to radio or internet because all systems were out due to the failure of the power network. The safety of our town was due to the efforts of our local emergency services, particularly the local police senior constable in his efforts to evacuate the town from the real threat that existed. While evacuated I have found it frustrating because the Khancoban area had very limited radio coverage, the incident

	 speak with any authority about fires in the Khancoban area. The NSW emergency services web site was at best sketchy with information sometimes over 1 day old. By comparison we received better information on fires in our area from the Victorian Emergency web site. But the straw that broke the 'camels back' for me was after returning from evacuation. I need to go to Tumbarumba for a Road Worthy Certificate, to renew my registration. Asking arount town and checking various web sites gave me conflicting information, including Live Traffic NSW. I decided to give it a try and was successful without any sign of road closures. I have included 2 files with the information from live traffic NSW. would not have attempted this trip even with one of the army's heavy vehicles particularly as the route requires a 4WD and passes through active fire areas in Victoria at the time. We are encouraged to listen on local radio and use the web for advice; it is no good if the advice is inaccurate, misleading or unavailable. Emergencies do not respect state borders it is time for state differences are resolved.


