Every hose wholesaler ran out of suction hose and firefighting hose. Every fittings supplier ran out of fire couplings and nozzles. For more than a month we received hundreds of phone calls every day from customers desperate to equip themselves to protect their properties and lives. And we could not deliver. It wasn't our fault or the wholesalers fault. It was just unprecedented demand. Even with very limited supply, we sold more firefighters in one day than we would normally sell in a
