In the lead up to the fires, our company the Hines Group P/L Received a call for assisted with 3 heavy plant units clearing containment lines and fire trails from Wingello to Exeter for a period of 8 days and up-until the 04.01.20 (All Voluntary)During this time we noticed the Gross waste of funds around the heavy plant and equipment sector eg Dozer's sitting around on standby rates for days on end, and other heavy plant being brought in from out of the area, floated straight past the plant which is on standby rates and working no more then 1/2 km down the road,
