Your story	I live at Smiths Lake which is considered a high risk fire danger area. This fire season we were lucky. A fire at Tarbuck Bay could have caused devastation in Smiths Lake but the wind was blowing away from us. There are many vacant blocks of land, including council land that have never been cleared in the 20 years that we have lived here. They are overgrown with plants like lantana etc. Because of the lack of water prior to this fire season they would have easily ignited if embers had come this way.
