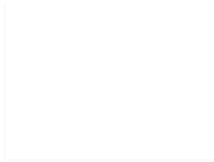

Your story In 2021 flood my property was flooded from the back, and the left side of my backyard. I lost everything in my granny flat, and shed. I had building insurance, only Since March 21 2021, my yard has been unusable, wet to smelly. I have a large sinkhole next to what used to be a granny flat Now redundant, cannot be used for anything.

Neighbours to the left of me keep pumping there bore water into my property. They set up deck chairs last year and watched and laughed as everything I worked for was destroyed.

1.1 Causes and contributing factors	Turn spear pumps OFF, asap.

1.3 Response to floods	Landowner [redacted] has repeatedly asked the squatters to remove unregistered cars garage doors, illegal fencing, violence and abuse from their property, to no avail.
1.4 Transition from incident response to recovery	Unblock access so damaged property can be removed easily, and let first responders have access to property.
1.5 Recovery from floods	My septic has been pumped out 3 days in a row, without me basically using it. Water keeps being pumped into my yard at all times of day and night
