If the stormwater drains were more efficient (wider) they might have better coped with the volume of water? 19 of our townhouses were fully flooded and a few more partially flooded (garages and sheds) - mine (number) was in the second category.

My request is that it be investigated if stormwater drains could be designed to cope with a larger flow of water.
