1.1 Causes and contributing factors

STORM WATER FLOODING

I specifically refer to the damage caused by storm water in what is now referred to as the 'Casino Basin', but my recommendation applies to all areas where property damage was incurred by storm water as distinct flood water.

Recommendation:

Areas where homes and businesses were flooded by the 'storm water' build up in drains, as distinct from flood waters, need to be assessed by hydrologists/engineers, independent of the local government council responsible for those services in their specific locations.

Their brief should include measures needed to avert a recurrence of such storm water flooding in the future. The findings should include the cause of the problems and measures needed to prevent a repeat of the problem.
