my car up too. I asked a man on the street of he thought it would flood to our street, he said maybe a few cms. I stayed awake. Around 4.15 I started hearing people from the street next to mine screaming and yelling and looked out the window to see people walking in knee deep water carrying animals on their shoulders. By 5.30 the water was at the start of my street, around 50 metres from my house. By 6 it had reached my yard. At 7.20 our power went off. I woke the children and we took limited belongings. I didn't think the water would get as high as it did.
