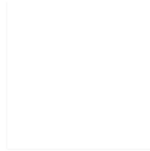

1.1 Causes and contributing factors

Our estates first entry road (Deadman's Creek Road) always flooded and a new road was built providing dual access points for the residents of this large estate. However the new Cumbalum Exchange was poorly planned and floods easily. Temporary access was provided via driving up south bound off ramp when water had receded enough to do so.

However for a few days all residents were stranded in an estate with absolutely no retail, food or medical facilities. Residents with children had to rely on neighbours and social media requests to share baby formula, food, nappies, medications, milk, etc.

We need a reliable road connecting this estate to a source of basic supplies.
