1.1 Causes and contributing factors

Flood mitigation works carried out by Lismore
City Council appears to not have considered that
widening Loftville Creek will result in the creeks
underpass on Krause Ave and Bruxner Hwy
being insufficient in size for the additional
capacity. This results in a flow regime that
causes the area to the west of the Kraus Ave
underpass to dam up and backfill to the south
eastern part of the Lismore airport general
aviation area. The lower laying hangars and the
refuelling facilities in this area is impacted by this
retained water.
