In 1974 flood my uncle rang and said they had record water at Jiggi upstream from Lismore.

Loaded stock from my Canvas business into 2 trucks and went to higher ground, so I had no stock loss. Good reliable information from people on the ground is essential, it has worked for us on many occasions. When the Lismore Levee was built North Lismore was left out, this was a blessing as when it flooded we knew we had to pack up. At the time we received a grant which had to spent on flood equipment eg: gantry lift, lofts and wheels on shelving etc.

Being on the outside of the Levee we have dealt with many floods, our building materials are now are brick, cement, hardwood, colourbond sheeting, and versalux sheeting. All the shelving is metal and are on wheels to allow ease of movement to Gantry to move upstairs to storage.

Hose out, dry out and repaint, and 90% of the time you are ready to go again.

Buildings in North Lismore worth looking at are , , , and our building which houses , are up and running again, admittedly after many long hours work.

My point of this submission is to say we need local knowledge made available to everyone to help with concerns of how much water is on the way at flood time....

Losses can be reduced by consideration what materials are used in the reconstruction process.
