# 1.1 Causes and contributing factors

Obviously significant rain event. BUT . . . the absolute lack of maintenance of drains, causeways and waterways by Council played a massive part. Council have repeatedly been requested to undertake maintenance in the north of the shire however have done little before the event. We could see that the floodwaters were increasing because of blocked/ broken pipes and blocked pipe inlets. If this maintenance was done prior to flood then the levels could have been 200-300mm less. This would have saved a number of properties, including ours.
