What I had a problem with is that Tucabia becomes an island when the Coldstream River floods but we have the new highway about 1 km away. I can hear the traffic on it from my home

it's quite loud tonight.

The people of this village need an access point onto that highway so we can access medications and food when Coldstream Terrace, Tyndale Rd and Wooli Rd are closed due to flooding. During this last flood I was told that a gate was opened off Firth Heinz Rd so people could get onto the highway. But there was no way of knowing when it was opened or closed unless you had inside information. This needs to be rectified.
