The assesors came through over a month later and found exposed aspestos in the walls making our rental property uninhabitable. We moved around 9

different emergency accommodation sites until we finally found another rental 2 1/2 months later. Me, my partner our baby and my brother and sister. Our new rental is 1/3 of the size of our previous property and more expensive. But we are thank full not to be homeless anymore...
