- Battery Bank for mobile (turn phone to aeroplane mode to save battery life)
- Transistor Radio & Batteries
- Torches/Lamps & Batteries
- Eskies, Camp Fridges, Gas Stoves, BBQ

- Safety Gear

- Waterproof Gear/Disposable Rain jacket
- Boots
- Gloves
- Helmet/Hat
- First Aid / Medications
- Food / Water
- Boat / Fuel / Life Jacket

- Closest Local Evacuation Centre and safest route out - heights at which you are cut off.

- Check on you neighbours

- Are they staying
- Where are the going
- Are pets going

- Have list of emergency contacts handy

- Be prepared in case of emergency evacuation

- Have Packed in waterproof bags
