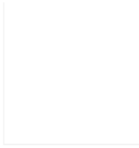

Your story	We have lived at this residence for almost 30yrs and have been in two major floods 2005 and 2022. We have recently renovated our property in 2019 builing in accordance to council flood hieght regulations and flooded above this height in February 2022. It is our opinion that unless Cudgen Lake and creek are flood controlled by a regulated storm water
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drainage system opening the creek to the ocean as it was originally ,we as Cabarita residents will continually be under the threat of flood. We feel helpless watching our beautiful Lake and Creek silt up and choke with no government authorities taking responsibility We have watched development of the area increase storm water run off and feel the scale of Kings Forest will definitely impact on the existing problem. It is irresponsible for authorities to neglect existing properties by lifting future development heights above new flood levels . Our once healthy water ways are no longer an asset with clean water, lillies ,frogs and native fish, now filled with reeds , introduced species of fish and silt it is becoming stagnant.
