1.2 Preparation and planning My submission is regarding the flood height predictions on the BOM website.

When predicting flood levels, continual reference to a flood height similar to a previous flood is useless and should be removed. Every flood is different. Wording such as "MAJOR FLOODING POSSIBLE AT GRAFTON ON MONDAY SIMILAR TO THE MARCH 2021 EVENT" is not beneficial. The comparison of the Feb 2022 flood to the previous March 2021 event was like chalk and cheese.

The March 2021 event peaked at Grafton at 6.58m, the Feb 22 event peaked at 7.66m, over a metre higher than then previous year.

Please do not compare floods until the event is over.
