1.4 Transition from incident response to recovery

Trauma all round. My mum is in respite in aged care. Her annual allocation is running out at end of May & then she will once again become a displaced person. A week after flood she was in emergency at Lusmore Base and has a cancer diagnosis. She wants to return to her home desperately. We have applied for disaster relief grant, with no idea of its progression as resilience nsw do not have a direct contact & services nsw customer service worker can't tell you anything.

1.5 Recovery from floods

When will the grants announced actual get to the people on the ground who are flood affected & traumatised. The only money released so far is going to private businesses/companies to carry out property assessments., my mum doesn't want structural grants. She would Like the \$20000 promised to spend as she sees fit . She would like assistance in furnishings, tiles, curtains etc
