During the height of the flood, an old friend

contacted 000 as their neighbour was experiencing a stroke. Told the best they could do was find someone with a boat (tinnie) and make the trip from Bungawalbin to Lismore for assistance... but it would be at least an hour before they could get a boat. Desperate to help, the old friend called my brother to see how he if he knew anyone in a position to help. My brother contacted his old helicopter crew from the army who had been deployed to the region... they were grounded and waiting in Casino for instructions from emergency services.... told by a ES operator to 'find something' they were only too happy to take on the rescue mission.

The patient was located and transported to a waiting Ambulance at SCU Lismore within 55 minutes of the call being made by the old friend to my brother... it saved the patients life.
